- 5.) Last year the BCA Div III Rescue experienced a large number of attained dogs. Hopefully with ongoing education, responsible breeders, and your support, these numbers will not continue to grow. They are looking for anyone willing to help on a temporary basis. Any aide you can provide would be greatly appreciated. Please contact Ken Haefliger, BCA Div. **FUTURITY MATCH**

- 1. Only puppies bred by members in good standing Pacific Coast Bulldog Club, Inc. are eligible.
- 2. The Futurity Match will be held at the August regular meeting.
- 3. The Bitch is nominated prior to breeding or no later than two (2) weeks after actual mating.
- 4. Nomination fee is ten dollars (\$10). No additional fees are required after the litter is born.
- 5. To keep the litter eligible the member must advise the Futurity Chairperson of the date and the number and sex of the puppies before puppies are sixty (60) days old or ten (10) days prior to judging of the Match, whichever comes first.
- 6. Puppies three (3) months and under fifteen (15) months old are eligible.
- 7. All fees to be paid to Futurity Chairperson.
- 8. Futurity Chairperson may show at this Match.
- 9. Puppies with points or Championship may show at this Match.
- 10. Puppies can only be shown once in a Futurity.
- 11. The breeder must be a member in good standing on date of the match for puppies to be shown.

**DIVISION OF FUTURITY MONEY**

- 12. Ten percent (10%) to be deducted for expenses.
- 13. Futurity Chairperson will purchase ribbons for First through Fourth Place.
- 14. The remaining monies is to be divided as follows: First Place receives forty percent (40%), Second Place receives thirty percent (30%), Third Place receives twenty percent (20%), Fourth Place receives ten percent (10%).
- 15. The club will provide a Trophy to go to the Winner of First Place to be held for one (1) year. Permanent Possession will be after three (3) wins of First Place. Not necessarily in succession.

JUDGE WILL BE SELECTED ACCORDING  
TO RULES FOR SELECTION OF JUDGES  
SLATE OF JUDGE NOMINATIONS SHALL BE VOTED ON  
TWO GENERAL MEETINGS PRIOR TO THE FUTURITY

**MANNER WHICH ENTRIES ARE JUDGED**

- 16. If the number of entries is less fifteen (15), then they are judges as one class, regardless of sex.
- 17. If the number of entries are fifteen (15) or more, the Class will be divided into Junior and Senior. Under and over six (6) months respectfully, regardless of sex.
- 18. From each Class the Judge selects the four (4) best entrants, then from the eight (8) finalists, the Judge awards First, Second, third and Fourth.

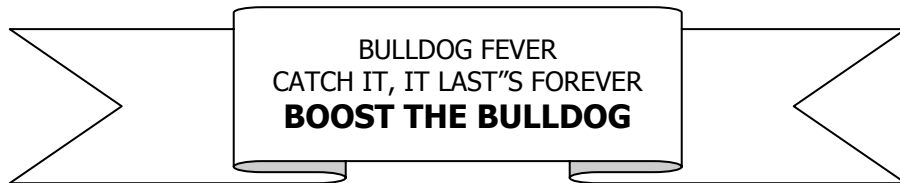

## **Surprising Things To Know About Dogs**

### **Fact: Dog Kisses Can Make You Sick**

Think dogs' mouths are cleaner than humans? Think again. Veterinarians say dogs' chops are teeming with germs like salmonella, campylobacter, and cryptosporidium. These germs get into a dog's mouth from eating spoiled food or when he uses his tongue as toilet paper. Then, a kiss moves these germs from pooch to person, along with a nasty course of diarrhea.

### **Myth: Licking Heals Dog' Wounds**

There is no magic healing power in dog saliva, contrary to popular belief. Quite the opposite: mouth bacteria may cause an infection that delays healing. Dogs are also prone to compulsive licking called *acral lick dermatitis* which creates sores that are hard to eradicate. The healing choice is usually an Elizabethan collar that blocks the dog's tongue from reaching a sore until it's completely healed.

### **Fact: Humans Can Make Pets Sick**

It's not common, but it happens. H1N1 "swine" flu has hit dogs, cats and ferrets contracted from their sick owners. Most often it's mild, but a few pets have died, so vets advise frequent hand-washing and separate beds when the owner is sick. Dogs and people can also share the same strains of E. coli bacteria. MRSA, the "superbug" is also making its way from humans to dogs.

### **Fact: Dogs Can learn up to 250 words**

The smartest, best trained breeds are similar to a 2-year-old child in their ability to understand human speech, according to researcher Stanley Coren, PhD. These dogs understand up to 250 words, while the average dog can understand 150 words.

**Top dog:** Border collie, poodle, German shepherd, golden retriever, Doberman pincher.

**Beauty Before Brains:** Bulldog, borzoi, chow chow, basenji, Afghan hound.

### **Myth: Dogs See in Black and White**

Not so, say canine researchers. Dogs see blue, violet, and many more shades of gray than humans. They also see better in low light and can pick up the slightest movement—a trait that makes them good hunters. They probably do not see red, orange, yellow, or green, based on examination of the color sensitive cone cells in canine retinas.

### **Dog Language: Grin and Bear It**

Owners who insist their dogs can smile are correct in thinking that the canine mouth can show emotions. Relaxed and open, it can be a sign of a happy dog. A submissive grin is a canine version of our nervous smile. Dogs pull their lips up, show their front teeth, and may crouch. This harmless, nervous "grin" is easily confused with an aggressive snarl. When in doubt, don't mess with the dog.

### **Fact: Dogs Can Smell Diabetes**

It sounds like a Lassie TV episode, but it's truth, not fiction. Dogs can sniff out a dangerous drop in blood sugar in a diabetic owner and alert the person to take action by pawing, licking, whining or barking. A few dogs have even been trained and placed as diabetic service dogs. Their nose for hypoglycemia (low blood sugar) is correct 90% of the time, according to their trainers.

### **Myth: Dogs Need Bones**

This practice comes from the idea that ancient dogs (wolves) ate plenty of bones. Today, pet dogs can get all the calcium and nutrients they need from dry kibble. Bones do satisfy the intense canine chewing instinct, but, they can choke a dog or splinter into knife-like shards, even when cooked. Edible chewies or sturdy rubber chew toys from the store are a safer choice.
