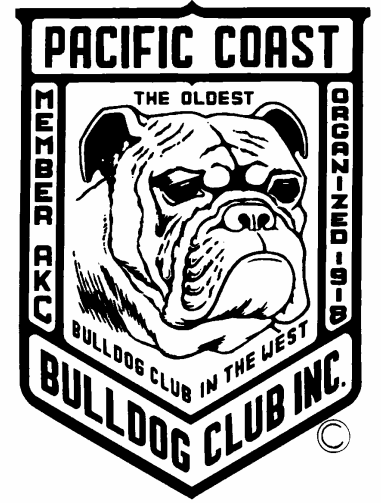

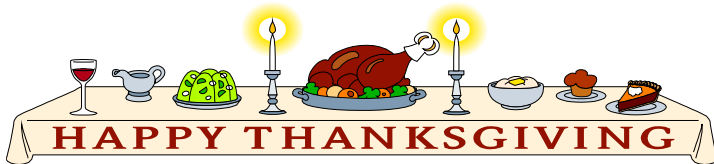

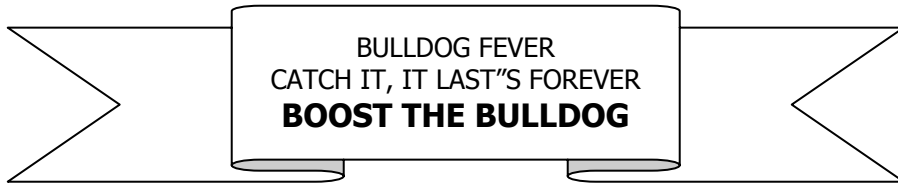

5 Health Mistakes Dog Owners Make

You want the best for your dog—your pooch is your best friend, after all. Yet sometimes, pet owners who mean well make serious mistakes, especially when it comes to the health of their dog.

Are you on the right track to keep your dog in top shape? We went to veterinarians to find out the most common health mistakes dog owners make and get their tips on how to avoid them.

Dog Health Mistake 1: Not Getting Preventive Care

Neglecting preventive health care is by far the most common mistake dog owners make, according to the veterinarians we interviewed. "Taking your dog in to the vet for regular examinations, giving heartworm prevention, and getting your dog the appropriate vaccinations and deworming can prevent many diseases," says Adrienne Brode, DMV, CCrp, associate medical director at the Canine Health Institute in Houston. For example, heartworm disease can be difficult to treat and ultimately fatal to dogs, but it's easily preventable. Yearly exams help your vet catch problems early, according to Oregon veterinarian Maria J. McGeorge, DMV. Instead of coping with lengthy treatment of an advanced or chronic condition, your vet can catch issues at their beginning stages, when care may mean cure. And early care saves you money in the long run.

Although annual exams may coincide with needed vaccinations, simply getting your dog vaccinated isn't the same as a full physical exam. Among things, a comprehensive check up may include:

- Blood work
- A fecal examination for intestinal parasites
- Examination of a dog's gums, heart, lungs, teeth, eyes, and ears

Talk to your veterinarian to learn more.

Dog Health Mistake 2: Neglecting Dental Care

Neglecting regular dental care is also common, according to Shawn Messonier, DMV, author of the *Natural Health Bible for Dogs and Cats*. Dogs need dental care for the same reason we do: to prevent gum disease.

As on human teeth, plaque form in a dog's teeth after eating. If left alone, the plaque builds, causing inflammation, decay, and eventually bone and tooth loss. And while this silent war goes on in your dog's mouth, it's probably experiencing pain you don't notice because dogs, like cats, instinctively hide pain.

Gum disease is actually five times as common in dogs as in people. But it's easy to prevent and to treat with dental care that includes:

- Daily brushings
- Good quality food
- Regular oral X-rays, exams. And cleanings
- Safe teath-cleaning treats and chew toys

Dog Health Mistake 3: Overfeeding

If too much love is ever a bad thing, it's when we show it to our canine companions in the form of too many tasty treats. "Rewarding and loving our dogs with food leads to obesity," Brode says. Overweight or obese dogs are at higher risk for arthritis and other orthopedic issues, as well as other health problems.

It can be difficult enough to balance our own diets, much less that of our dogs so, talk to your vet, who will help you select a good, high quality food for your dog and give you tips on exercise and treats. That's right—you don't have to stop sharing occasional goodies with your pooch, as long as 90% to 95% of your dog's diet is healthy and well balanced.

Dog Health Mistake 4: Sharing Medication

Another dangerous health mistake owners make is giving dogs human medications. "Pain medications like Advil or Tylenol can be very toxic to dogs," says Brode. In fact, there is a host of seemingly benign human drugs that can pose grave health risks for pets. Non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs), such as ibuprofen, are the most common cause of pet poisoning in small animals, according to the ASPCA. Even small doses can be toxic. Antidepressants, muscle relaxers, decongestants, vitamin D derivatives, oral diabetes treatments, and other common human drugs can all pose risks to pets, from seizures to coma to death.

Always keep medication secure -- preferably in a high, locked cabinet -- and never discard medication where pets or children can get to it. If you're worried that your dog may have gobbled up an over-the-counter or prescription pill you dropped, or worse, taken an entire bottle from the trash, don't hesitate. Immediately call the Animal Poison Control Center 24-hour hotline at (888) 426-4435.

Dog Health Mistake 5: Delaying Critical Care

We often delay medical care of ourselves, waiting for a bump, pain, or rash to go away so, it may seem natural to do the same thing with our dog.

There's a problem with that however; dogs don't have the words to let us know exactly what they're feeling. Your canine companion could be in pain, sick, and even gravely ill and chances are you wouldn't know it because of dogs' instinct to hide infirmity.

Don't wait to see if a health problem in your dog gets better on its own. Call your vet if your dog isn't eating or is eating less, vomiting, lethargic, has diarrhea or fever, or just doesn't seem well.

BREEDER'S CONDUCT

1. Anyone breeding his or her bitch bears a great responsibility to the future of the breed. Therefore, a breeder shall plan each breeding with the paramount intention of advancing and protecting the breed, and only when they are in a position to give proper care to both bitch and offspring. The owner of a bitch, if inexperienced, should consult with the breeder of the dog they own or with some other experienced breeder before undertaking any breeding.
2. Recognizing the extended growth pattern of the bulldog, the breeder shall not breed the bitch prior to 12 months of age. Back-to-back litters are not encouraged. After a bitch is five (5) years old, her owner should seek the opinion of a veterinarian regarding her health for breeding.
3. All Bulldog bitches being bred shall be sound and have typical structure and conformation and shall be of good temperament.
4. No breeder shall offer at stud any Bulldog who does not meet the above qualifications.
5. If the stud dog is unproven or has had breeding problems in the past, such information shall be provided to the owner of the bitch before the bitch is bred.
6. The owner of the stud is under no obligation to service a bitch that is not as represented by her owner or who presents serious hereditary defects.
7. Owners of stud and bitch shall sign a written agreement, clearly stating the conditions and terms of service. An agreement should also include what type of breeding will take place (natural, AI, chilled semen, frozen semen).
8. It is the obligation of the breeder to honestly and fairly inform the owner of the stud dog or bitch, as well as all buyers of pups, all known or suspected medical conditions or health problems.
9. A breeder shall be available to his buyers for whatever reasonable advice and assistance they may need.
10. No PCBC member shall engage in wholesaling litters or individual sales or consignments of pups or adults to pet shops, dealers, catalog houses or other commercial establishments, nor shall they be donated or given as prizes in contests, raffles, or fundraising events, no matter how charitable.
11. The breeder will ask the buyer(s) to advise him if they are ever unable to keep their Bulldog, so the breeder can either take the dog back or give every assistance to place it in a new home.
12. Breeders are encouraged to:
 - a. Not allow a puppy to leave for its new home before the age of 8 weeks.
 - b. Supply a pedigree of no less than three (3) generations, plus AKC registration papers.
 - c. Supply records which detail all dates and types of medical care given the pup, including all vaccinations for the pup's age.
 - d. Request that buyers take their pup to a veterinarian of their choice within 10 days of receipt, and if the pup is deemed unhealthy or if the buyer is not satisfied that the pup is as represented by the breeder, owe the buyers a full refund of the purchase price paid or another pup. (All shipping to be paid by the buyer).

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

By signing and submitting this application for membership consideration, applicant authorizes and agrees to hold harmless and without liability the PCBC, its officers, and its members to investigate, solicit, obtain and discuss any and all information pertaining to an applicant's moral and ethical character as it relates to the standards and guidelines set by the PCBC and which is believed by the PCBC, its officers, and its members to have a hearing upon applicant's moral and ethical character. Applicant acknowledges that all information gathered shall be open for review and discussion among the PCBC, its officers, and its members as part of the PCBC Membership Application Process.

CODE OF ETHICS

- Members of PCBC/BCA have an obligation to protect the welfare and the best interests of their breed by conducting themselves in a manner designed to reflect credit to themselves, their breed, and PCBC/BCA.
- Members who exhibit are expected to observe the highest standards of sportsmanship, conduct themselves in such a manner as to reflect positively on the sport of showing dogs, and exhibit good will at all shows and obedience trials.
- Members who contemplate breeding a litter, or who allow the use of their stud dog for the same purpose, shall direct their efforts toward producing dogs of quality, of even temperament, of vigorous health and free of health problems. They shall be familiar with the bulldog breed and its PCBC/BCA/AKC approved standard and breed only those specimens which conform to it.
- Members shall not engage in false or misleading advertising or misrepresentation of their breed, nor shall they malign their competition by making false or misleading statements regarding their competitor's dogs, breeding practice(s) or person.

Blatant disregard for the standards set out in the Breeder's Code, Release of Liability, and Code of Ethics shall be considered unacceptable behavior and not supported by the Pacific Coast Bulldog Club, the Bulldog Club of America, and the American Kennel Club.
