## FUTURITY MATCH

1. Only puppies bred by members in good standing Pacific Coast Bulldog Club, Inc. are eligible.
2. The Futurity Match will be held at the August regular meeting (which actual meeting date is to be determined).
3. The Bitch is nominated prior to breeding or no later than two (2) weeks after actual mating.
4. Nomination fee is ten dollars (\$10). No additional fees are required after the litter is born.
5. To keep the litter eligible the member must advise the Futurity Chairperson of the date and the number and sex of the puppies before puppies are sixty (60) days old or ten (10) days prior to judging of the Match, whichever comes first.
6. Puppies three (3) months and under fifteen (15) months old are eligible.
7. All fees to be paid to Futurity Chairperson.
8. Futurity Chairperson may show at this Match.
9. Puppies with points or Championship may show at this Match.
10. Puppies can only be shown once in a Futurity.
11. The breeder must be a member in good standing on date of the match for puppies to be shown.

### DIVISION OF FUTURITY MONEY

12. Ten percent (10%) to be deducted for expenses.
13. Futurity Chairperson will purchase ribbons for First through Fourth Place.
14. The remaining money is to be divided as follows: First Place receives forty percent (40%), Second Place receives thirty percent (30%), Third Place receives twenty percent (20%), Fourth Place receives ten percent (10%).
15. The club will provide a Trophy to go to the Winner of First Place to be held for one (1) year. Permanent Possession will be after three (3) wins of First Place. Not necessarily in succession.

JUDGE WILL BE SELECTED ACCORDING  
TO RULES FOR SELECTION OF JUDGES  
SLATE OF JUDGE NOMINATIONS SHALL BE VOTED ON  
TWO GENERAL MEETINGS PRIOR TO THE FUTURITY

### MANNER WHICH ENTRIES ARE JUDGED

16. If the number of entries is less fifteen (15), then they are judges as one class, regardless of sex.
17. If the number of entries are fifteen (15) or more, the Class will be divided into Junior and Senior. Under and over six (6) months respectfully, regardless of sex.
18. From each Class the Judge selects the four (4) best entrants, then from the eight (8) finalists, the Judge awards First, Second, third and Fourth.

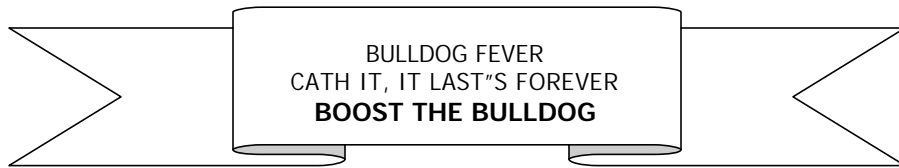

## Dehydration and Water Needs in Dogs (Cont.)

### Are Certain Dogs Prone to Dehydration?

Dogs most at risk for dehydration are those who suffer from various illnesses such as kidney disorders, cancer and infectious disease. Elderly dogs and pregnant or nursing dogs may be prone to dehydration, as well as diabetic dogs whose condition is not regularly monitored.

### How Is Dehydration Treated?

A veterinarian will administer intravenous or subcutaneous fluids, and run additional tests, if necessary, to determine the underlying cause of the condition.

### How Can I Prevent Dehydration?

- Provide clean water at all times, and change it frequently to ensure freshness. Also, don't forget to wash your pet's water bowl every day to prevent bacteria from forming.
- Monitor your dog's water intake. Generally, a dog needs at least one ounce of water for each pound of body weight per day. If your dog is not drinking an adequate amount of water, seek veterinary advice. Monitoring water intake is especially important if he's recovering from diarrhea, vomiting or other illnesses.
- Purchase a water bowl with a weighted bottom to prevent your dog from knocking it over.
- Bring extra water when you're traveling or exercising with your dog.
- If you notice your pet is drinking less than usual, check his mouth for sores or other foreign objects, such as burrs or sticks.
- Avoid chaining a dog outside, since he may get tangled up, preventing him from accessing his water bowl.
- Keep your toilet lid closed to interrupt your dog's efforts to turn the bowl, which can be a source of bacteria, into a water fountain.

## Flatulence (Passing Gas) in Dogs

Dogs who pass often gas can embarrass or distress their owners. The most common cause of flatulence is swallowing large amounts of air while gulping food. The next is eating highly fermentable foods such as onions, beans, cauliflower, cabbage, and soybeans. Flatulence also occurs with malabsorption syndromes. The excess gas is related to incomplete digestion of carbohydrates. Boxers are renowned for flatulence problems.

A sudden bout of flatulence, accompanied by abdominal discomfort, loss of appetite, or diarrhea, is an indication to seek veterinary attention.

**Treatment:** It's important to first rule out any malabsorption syndrome. Change the dog's food to a highly digestible, low-fiber diet, and avoid giving table scraps. Feed three small meals instead of one large meal to keep the dog from gulping food and swallowing air. If this does not stop the flatulence, consider switching to a prescription diet such as Hill's i/d or Hill's k/d, available from your veterinarian.

If further treatment is desired, simethicone can be given to absorb intestinal gas. Simethicone is available over the counter for people as a liquid or tablets. The dose for dogs is 40mg once or twice a day after meals. Charcoal-based treats and biscuits, and supplements that contain yucca, may also assist with gas.

## Dehydration and Water Needs in Dogs

Dehydration is a lack of water in the body, and can cause serious complications for pets and people alike. Water is essential to all living beings, including dogs, who depend on proper daily fluid intake to maintain appropriate health. It makes up 80 percent of your dog's body, and dissolves natural and unnatural substances as well as serves as the root of all his biological processes, including circulation, digestion and waste removal.

### **What Causes Dehydration in Dogs?**

Dehydration occurs when fluid levels drop to less than normal. This is due to either reduced water intake or increased fluid loss. Fluid loss can be due to overheating in hot weather or a bout of vomiting or diarrhea, especially in puppies.

#### What Are the General Symptoms of Dehydration in Dogs?

- Sunken eyes
- Lethargy
- Loss of appetite
- Dry mouth
- Depression

### **What Should I Do If I Think My Dog Is Dehydrated?**

Dehydration may indicate a serious underlying problem. If you suspect that your dog is dehydrated, take him to a veterinarian immediately. You may be able to detect dehydration at home by gently lifting the skin on the back of your dog's neck or between the shoulder blades—unless your dog is seriously overweight or very thin, it should immediately return to a normal position. If he is lacking in fluids, the lifted skin may not quickly return to normal. Often, however, the signs of dehydration are not obvious, and only a veterinarian can provide proper diagnosis and treatment.
