Dog Mange (Scabies)

Scabies, tiny spiderlike mites, are highly contagious and are transmitted primarily by direct contact and through contaminated grooming equipment and kennels. These mites are also transferable to humans and other pets.

Probably no other skin disease will cause your dog to scratch and bite at their skin with such intensity. The severe itching is caused by female mites tunneling a few millimeters under the skin to lay their eggs. The eggs hatch in 3 to 10 days. The immature mites develop into adults and begin to lay eggs of their own. The entire life cycle occurs on the dog's skin, and takes just 17 to 21 days.

Scabies attacks the skin of the ears, elbows, hocks, and the underside of the chest and face. The onset is abrupt with scratching, hair loss, and inflamed skin in these areas. Crusty ear tips are characteristic. A classic test for scabies is to rub the ear flap between your fingers and watch the dog scratch on the same side. In the later stages the skin becomes thick, crusted, scaly, and darkly pigmented.

Scabies in people can produce an itchy rash, typically found at the belt line. This rash is caused by insects that have transferred from the dog. Scabies mites, however, do not live on human skin for longer than three weeks. If the problem does not disappear in three weeks, look for a continuing source of infestation.

The diagnosis is made by examining skin scrapings under a microscope. In some cases the mites may not be identified. If the dog's symptoms strongly suggest scabies, your veterinarian may decide to begin treatment as a diagnostic test. A positive response to the treatment confirms the diagnosis of scabies.

Treatment: Scabies must be treated under veterinary supervision. Clip the hair away from scabies-affected areas on medium- and longhaired dogs and bathe the entire animal using a benzoyl peroxide shampoo (such as OxyDex or Pyoben). The shampoo loosens scales and makes it possible for an insecticide dip to penetrate the hair pores.

Scabies mites have developed resistance to a number of organophosphate dips. Two dips that remain active against them are amitraz (brand name Mitaban) and 2 to 4 percent lime-sulfur (LymDyp). Only lime-sulfur is licensed by the FDA to treat scabies in dogs. However, LymDyp has an unpleasant odor, stains white coats, and can irritate the skin.

Dip the dog once a week for six consecutive weeks (or until the symptoms resolve), using the dip recommended by your veterinarian. Continue treatment for two more weeks after the dogs appears to be cured. When using any dip, carefully follow the instructions on the label. For information on how to dip, see Insecticide Dips, page 132. It is important to treat all dogs who have come into contact with the affected individual.

Oral ivermectin is effective against scabies and is frequently used as a diagnostic test when skin scrapings have been negative. Ivermectin, in doses used for scabies, has produced central nervous system problems and deaths in Collies, Shetland Sheepdogs, Old English Sheepdogs, Australian Shepherds, and other herding breeds and their crosses. The drug is contraindicated in these breeds at the higher dosages. Dogs of these breeds must be tested for the MDR 1 (multi-drug resistance) gene by having your veterinarian send a cheek swab to Washington State University College of Veterinary Medicine.

Always have the heartworm status of your dog checked before giving ivermectin, because it may cause a reaction in dogs who are positive for the heartworm larvae. Recent reports suggest that Interceptor (milbemycin oxime) may also be effective against scabies mites, and could be used instead of ivermectin in breeds in which ivermectin is contraindicated. Revolution (selamectin) is also labeled to help in preventing and treating sarcoptic mange in dogs.

Corticosteroids relieve severe itching and may be required for the first two to three days of treatment. Infected skin sores require oral and topical antibiotics. Adult mites can live for 21 days off the host.

Treatment of the indoor environment is advisable to prevent recurrence.

Dogs and Tear Stains

Your snow-white poodle is so cute -- but he'd be even cuter without those reddish-brown streaks under his eyes. Dogeye discharge and tear staining are common problems, especially with certain breeds. So, what causes these issues, and what can you do to remedy them? WebMD offers answers to four common questions about dog eye problems and discharge.

1. What causes tear stains under a dog's eyes?

Excessive tearing, technically called epiphora, can occur as a result of irritation to your dog's eyes or because your dog's tears are not draining properly.

Just as your eye waters if a speck of dust blows into it, dogs' eyes will make tears when irritated to flush away anything harmful. When the eyes are continually irritated, this can lead to chronic tearing that produces stains. Conditions that might irritate the eye include dog eye infections, glaucoma, and eyelash or eyelid problems.

In a normal dog eye, there are small holes that drain tears away from the eye and down the throat. A variety of dog eye problems can affect this drainage, causing excessively watery eyes. These conditions include:

- Shallow eye sockets. If the eye sockets aren't big or deep enough, tears can spill out onto the fur around the eyes.
- Eyelids that are turned inward. If the eyelids roll in toward the eyeball, the drainage holes for tears (called puncta) may become blocked.
- Hair growth around the eye. If hair grows too close to the eye, it can wick tears away from the eye and onto the face.
- Blocked tear drainage holes (puncta). Previous dog eye infections or eye damage can cause scar tissue to form that blocks some of the drainage passages for tears.

2. Which types or breeds of dogs are more susceptible to dog eye discharge and tear stains?

Regardless of breed, white dogs are more likely to have visible tear staining on their faces, because the pigments in their tears can easily dye light-colored fur. Also, dogs with long hair on their faces may be more prone to excessive tearing. Short-nosed dog breeds, such as Shih-tzu, Pekingese, Maltese, and pug, are prone to excessive tearing because they often have

shallow eye sockets or hair growth in skin folds around the eyes that cause problems. Also, cocker spaniels and poodles are more likely than other breeds to have blocked tear ducts.

3. Can the dog eye problems that cause tear stains be treated?

It depends on the condition leading to excessive tearing. There is no way to stop dog eye discharge because of shallow eye sockets, so the goal in this situation is to minimize skin irritation and coat discoloration.

If your dog's tear stains are developing because his eyes are always irritated, eliminating the source of irritation will help. This might include keeping hair near the eyes trimmed very short and treating infection or glaucoma, if present.

There are surgical options for certain eyelid or eyelash problems that can restore normal tear drainage and eliminate overflow onto the face.

4. What can I do to get rid of my dog's tear stains?

Although those reddish-brown stains can be stubborn, there are certain remedies that may minimize their appearance. These include:

- Antibiotics. The antibiotics tetracycline and tylosin are sometimes used to address tear staining, as they reduce or eliminate the likelihood that tear stains will form. There are concerns about the use of antibiotics for this purpose on an ongoing basis, however, because it could lead to the development of drug-resistant bacteria, which would be far more dangerous to your pup than a few unsightly stains.
- Whitening products. Swabbing the stains with hydrogen peroxide or using special grooming products designed for pet fur may help with tear stains.
- Regular washing of your dog's face.

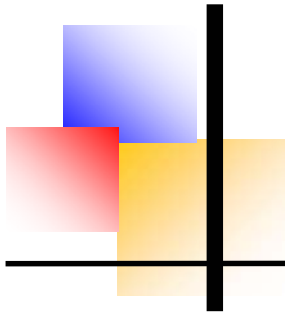

BREEDER'S CONDUCT

1. Anyone breeding his or her bitch bears a great responsibility to the future of the breed. Therefore, a breeder shall plan each breeding with the paramount intention of advancing and protecting the breed, and only when they are in a position to give proper care to both bitch and offspring. The owner of a bitch, if inexperienced, should consult with the breeder of the dog they own or with some other experienced breeder before undertaking any breeding.
2. Recognizing the extended growth pattern of the bulldog, the breeder shall not breed the bitch prior to 12 months of age. Back-to-back litters are not encouraged. After a bitch is five (5) years old, her owner should seek the opinion of a veterinarian regarding her health for breeding.
3. All Bulldog bitches being bred shall be sound and have typical structure and conformation and shall be of good temperament.
4. No breeder shall offer at stud any Bulldog who does not meet the above qualifications.
5. If the stud dog is unproven or has had breeding problems in the past, such information shall be provided to the owner of the bitch before the bitch is bred.
6. The owner of the stud is under no obligation to service a bitch that is not as represented by her owner or who presents serious hereditary defects.
7. Owners of stud and bitch shall sign a written agreement, clearly stating the conditions and terms of service. An agreement should also include what type of breeding will take place (natural, AI, chilled semen, frozen semen).
8. It is the obligation of the breeder to honestly and fairly inform the owner of the stud dog or bitch, as well as all buyers of pups, all known or suspected medical conditions or health problems.
9. A breeder shall be available to his buyers for whatever reasonable advice and assistance they may need.
10. No PCBC member shall engage in wholesaling litters or individual sales or consignments of pups or adults to pet shops, dealers, catalog houses or other commercial establishments, nor shall they be donated or given as prizes in contests, raffles, or fundraising events, no matter how charitable.
11. The breeder will ask the buyer(s) to advise him if they are ever unable to keep their Bulldog, so the breeder can either take the dog back or give every assistance to place it in a new home.
12. Breeders are encouraged to:
 - a. Not allow a puppy to leave for its new home before the age of 8 weeks.
 - b. Supply a pedigree of no less than three (3) generations, plus AKC registration papers.
 - c. Supply records which detail all dates and types of medical care given the pup, including all vaccinations for the pup's age.
 - d. Request that buyers take their pup to a veterinarian of their choice within 10 days of receipt, and if the pup is deemed unhealthy or if the buyer is not satisfied that the pup is as represented by the breeder, owe the buyers a full refund of the purchase price paid or another pup. (All shipping to be paid by the buyer).

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

By signing and submitting this application for membership consideration, applicant authorizes and agrees to hold harmless and without liability the PCBC, its officers, and its members to investigate, solicit, obtain and discuss any and all information pertaining to an applicant's moral and ethical character as it relates to the standards and guidelines set by the PCBC and which is believed by the PCBC, its officers, and its members to have a hearing upon applicant's moral and ethical character. Applicant acknowledges that all information gathered shall be open for review and discussion among the PCBC, its officers, and its members as part of the PCBC Membership Application Process.

CODE OF ETHICS

- Members of PCBC/BCA have an obligation to protect the welfare and the best interests of their breed by conducting themselves in a manner designed to reflect credit to themselves, their breed, and PCBC/BCA.
- Members who exhibit are expected to observe the highest standards of sportsmanship, conduct themselves in such a manner as to reflect positively on the sport of showing dogs, and exhibit good will at all shows and obedience trials.
- Members who contemplate breeding a litter, or who allow the use of their stud dog for the same purpose, shall direct their efforts toward producing dogs of quality, of even temperament, of vigorous health and free of health problems. They shall be familiar with the bulldog breed and its PCBC/BCA/AKC approved standard and breed only those specimens which conform to it.
- Members shall not engage in false or misleading advertising or misrepresentation of their breed, nor shall they malign their competition by making false or misleading statements regarding their competitor's dogs, breeding practice(s) or person.

Blatant disregard for the standards set out in the Breeder's Code, Release of Liability, and Code of Ethics shall be considered unacceptable behavior and not supported by the Pacific Coast Bulldog Club, the Bulldog Club of America, and the American Kennel Club.

2. All legal owners and co-owners of the dog **MUST** be members of Pacific Coast Bulldog Club, Inc. in good standing at the time the required ten (10) points, including one (1) major are earned.
3. Those who apply for a plaque and do not meet the requirements will receive a Championship Certificate. All members who finish a Champion in the United States, regardless of locality, are entitled to a Championship Certificate and may apply for only the certificate by checking the appropriate box.
4. The Championship Award Application can be obtained from the Championship Award Chairperson or the Bullpup Editor.
5. The completed application must be submitted with a copy of the AKC Championship Certificate, the AKC Registration Certificate, and a 8x10 colored show photo or a good quality colored photo copy of the new champion no later than December 31st of the year prior to the Specialty Show to the Championship Award Chairperson.
