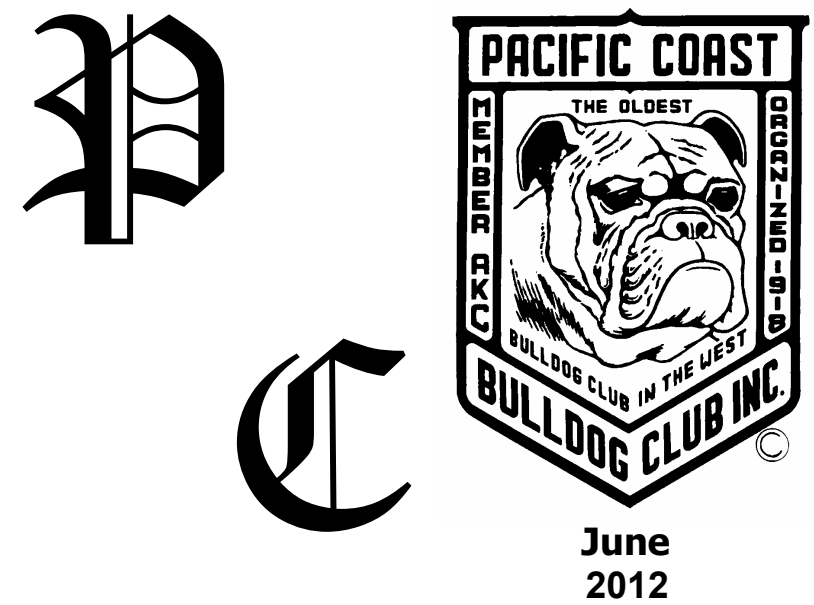

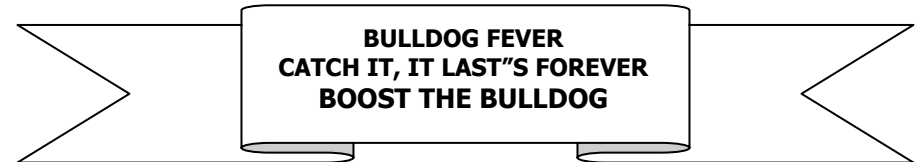

**FUTURITY MATCH**

- 1. Only puppies bred by members in good standing Pacific Coast Bulldog Club, Inc. are eligible.
- 2. The Futurity Match will be held at the August regular meeting.
- 3. The Bitch is nominated prior to breeding or no later than two (2) weeks after actual mating.
- 4. Nomination fee is ten dollars (\$10). No additional fees are required after the litter is born.
- 5. To keep the litter eligible the member must advise the Futurity Chairperson of the date and the number and sex of the puppies before puppies are sixty (60) days old or ten (10) days prior to judging of the Match, whichever comes first.
- 6. Puppies three (3) months and under fifteen (15) months old are eligible.
- 7. All fees to be paid to Futurity Chairperson.
- 8. Futurity Chairperson may show at this Match.
- 9. Puppies with points or Championship may show at this Match.
- 10. Puppies can only be shown once in a Futurity.
- 11. The breeder must be a member in good standing on date of the match for puppies to be shown.

**DIVISION OF FUTURITY MONEY**

- 12. Ten percent (10%) to be deducted for expenses.
- 13. Futurity Chairperson will purchase ribbons for First through Fourth Place.
- 14. The remaining money is to be divided as follows: First Place receives forty percent (40%), Second Place receives thirty percent (30%), Third Place receives twenty percent (20%), Fourth Place receives ten percent (10%).
- 15. The club will provide a Trophy to go to the Winner of First Place to be held for one (1) year. Permanent Possession will be after three (3) wins of First Place. Not necessarily in succession.

JUDGE WILL BE SELECTED ACCORDING  
TO RULES FOR SELECTION OF JUDGES  
SLATE OF JUDGE NOMINATIONS SHALL BE VOTED ON  
TWO GENERAL MEETINGS PRIOR TO THE FUTURITY

**MANNER WHICH ENTRIES ARE JUDGED**

- 16. If the number of entries is less fifteen (15), then they are judges as one class, regardless of sex.
- 17. If the number of entries are fifteen (15) or more, the Class will be divided into Junior and Senior. Under and over six (6) months respectfully, regardless of sex.
- 18. From each Class the Judge selects the four (4) best entrants, then from the eight (8) finalists, the Judge awards First, Second, third and Fourth.

## Caring for English Bulldogs in Summer

Please Do Not Use This Article in the Place of a Veterinarian's Diagnosis

Bulldogs, better known as English bulldogs are challenging dogs to live with because many suffer from one or more health issues. But bulldog caretakers need to keep in mind the special challenges of summertime -- heat, bees and large bodies of water. Bulldogs are prone to heat stroke, can be allergic to bee stings and cannot swim.

### **Heat Stroke**

The endearing short --nosed expression of a bulldog comes at a great price. The brachycephalic or flat nose makes it difficult for a bulldog to breathe normally. That's why bulldogs snort and snore all of the time. This makes all dogs with flat faces, including bulldogs, far more prone to dying from heat stroke than dogs with longer noses.

Bulldogs should stay inside air-conditioned homes as much as possible during hot and humid conditions. Dogs should be walked in the cool of the evening or in the pre-dawn hours. Bring bottles of water and a dog bowl with you on walks. Pay close attention to how hard the dog is panting. If the dog is panting, stop the walk, get into shade and give water. And, of course, never leave your bulldog in a car during the summer.

### **Bee Stings**

Not all bulldogs will be allergic to bee or wasp stings. However, if the dog has been stung in the face or neck, any swelling can greatly interfere with the dog's already compromised airways, notes "Bulldog: Your Happy, Healthy Pet" (John Wiley and Sons; 2008.) Contact your vet immediately if your dog has been stung and begins swelling, struggles to breathe or exhibits any sudden and unusual behavior.

A quick home remedy for bee stings is giving two 25 milligram Benedryl (diphenhydramine) tablets for a 50 pound bulldog. Pills can be slipped into a peanut butter sandwich, cheese or Pill Pockets. However, you should always call your vet first before giving your dog any human medication, including Benedryl.

### **Can't Swim**

Bulldogs are built like fuzzy bricks. Unfortunately, they swim exactly like fuzzy bricks. "Bulldogs For Dummies" (Wiley Publishing; 2005) sadly notes that drowning is a leading cause of death in bulldogs. Dogs do not instinctively know how to swim. Keep bulldogs away from all pools, lakes, rivers or any other bodies of water unless they are wearing life jackets specifically made for dogs.

Bulldogs do enjoy kiddie wading pools, especially on hot, humid days. But the pool's depth needs to only reach the dog's belly, at the very most.

## Insect Stings

For most of us, bee and wasp stings are painful and can cause localized swelling. But for some individuals, an insect sting can also cause a fatal allergic reaction to the venom. These insects will not only sting humans, but also animals which can have the same type of reaction as humans. Bulldogs and other short-nosed breeds are especially susceptible to allergic swelling causing obstruction of breathing passages.

Usually a single sting does not present a serious problem. The exception can be the sting on the nose, mouth or around the head. If the swelling is minor, just watch the dog to be sure he is not having breathing or swallowing difficulties. If the swelling drastically increases within five or ten minutes, see a vet immediately. It is always better to be safe than sorry.

If your dog is stung by multiple bees or wasps then see a veterinarian immediately. At this point veterinary treatment is directed at preventing shock, maintaining fluid volume and protecting the various organ systems at risk.

### **What to do if a dog is stung by a single bee or wasp:**

- Remove stinger; only bees have stingers.
- Administer an antihistamine such as Benedryl.
- Make a paste of baking soda and water and apply to the sting area.
- Apply an ice pack to relieve swelling and pain and alternate it on and off the sting site.
- Sit and comfort the dog until the pain has gone away. If the pain does not go away shortly then prompt veterinarian care is a necessity.

The effects of the venom from bee stings may not become apparent for several hours or days. Even if your dog escapes the allergic threat of the toxins, there may be damage to the liver, kidneys, nervous system or blood cells. It is always safest to seek veterinary attention immediately.

## Dog Park Etiquette: 7 Rules

### How to keep your dog out of trouble at the dog park.

For a pent-up dog, a trip to the dog park can be pure bliss. The dog gets to burn off energy, get some exercise, and play off leash with other dogs. And dog parks can be a great place for owners to socialize with other dog lovers and their pets.

But just like any playground, dog parks can be scenes of bullying and fighting. What happens when one dog won't stop humping the others, starts a fight, or guards the dog park like his own front lawn?

And what if - heaven forbid -- the offending dog is yours?

WebMD consulted with dog behavior experts about the best ways to avoid conflicts and make the most out of your trip to the dog park. Here are their tips:

#### 1. Use common sense.

If your dog is sick or in heat, don't bring it to the dog park. Same goes for dogs with a history of aggression toward other dogs, says Kimberly Anne May, DVM, MS, an assistant director at the American Veterinary Medical Association.

"You can work with a trainer or a veterinary behaviorist to try to get your dog's aggression curbed so it can be a good citizen at these parks," May says, but for some dogs, "it's just not appropriate."

#### 2. Look before you enter.

Before stepping into the park, watch how the other dogs and owners are interacting. If one dog steals another's toy or jumps on someone, does his owner pretend it didn't happen? You don't want your dog picking up bad social habits or getting victimized by another dog, says Sophia Yin, DVM, MS, spokeswoman for the American Veterinary Society of Animal Behavior and author of *How to Behave So Your Dog Behaves*.

"It would be similar to saying, 'Let's bring my kid to the playground and its OK if he hits other kids because he's just playing,'" Yin says.

#### 3. Ease into it.

If it's your first time, go early in the morning or in the middle of a weekday, when there's less likely to be a crowd. Observe how your dog handles himself. If he's trying to hide behind you, licking his lips and yawning, or looking in different directions, those are signs he's afraid and wants to leave - and you should listen. A fearful dog can easily become an aggressor, Yin says.

"[With] a lot of people, you see their dog is trying to get out of the situation and they're just standing there and their dog is like, 'Is someone going to help me?'" Yin says. "And then ... their dog snaps at another dog."

#### 4. Stay in command.

Most problems can be averted if your dog is trained to come when called, "meaning that you call them and the dog, within a split second, turns and runs full speed toward you," Yin says.

#### 5. Know the difference between playing and fighting.

Well-socialized dogs will display a relaxed posture, take turns chasing each other, and pause frequently to calm themselves down, says Cheryl S. Smith, certified dog behavior consultant and author of *Visiting the Dog Park: Having Fun, Staying Safe*.

"Part of play is that the one that would normally win a fight is not out to win, they're just out to have a good time. So they take turns being on the bottom when they're wrestling, and who's the quote 'aggressor' and who's the one being chased," Smith says.

Although a little humping, butt sniffing, or even growling is typical, incessant pestering from another dog can trigger conflicts. Dogs generally do a good job of telling each other to back off by showing their teeth or growling. But some dogs don't get the message.

#### 6. Take responsibility.

If your dog is the one humping or stalking the others, call him off and move to another area of the park - or leave.

"Anything that makes another dog or their owner uncomfortable is inappropriate," Yin says.

That approach works for Atlanta dog owner Nick Carpentieri, whose boxer mix, Elliot, always gets in a standoff with one particular dog.

"If I see the dog here, I don't even come in," Carpentieri says. The other dog's owner does the same.

#### 7. Act quickly if a fight breaks out.

If you have access to a garden hose or spray bottle, spray the dogs until they back away. If that doesn't work, the owners should grab the dogs' back legs and pick them up like a wheelbarrow, backing up slowly, Smith says.

"Most people grab for the head, and you're likely to get bit unintentionally," Smith says.

If your dog causes an injury or you suspect it might be injured, exchange names and phone numbers with the other dog owner before leaving the park.

**Faulty Fronts**



A vertical rectangle between the front legs indicates a front too narrow.  
A horizontal rectangle could be legs too short or loose shoulders.

**ELBOWS** – The elbows should be low stand well out and loose from the body.

“Loose from the body” does NOT mean overly loose elbows.  
It means they should not be directed toward the ribs (tight elbows).  
Neither should they be directed outward away from the ribs (overly loose elbows). Overly loose elbows is a VERY serious structural fault.

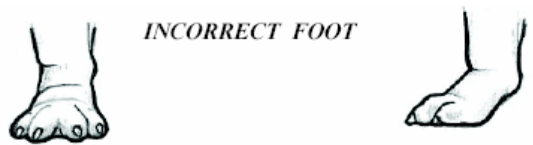
**FRONT FEET** – The feet should be moderate in size, compact and firmly set. Toes compact, well split up, with high knuckles and very short stubby nails. The front feet may be straight or slightly outturned

**In a correct foot, the two middle nails are very close together.**



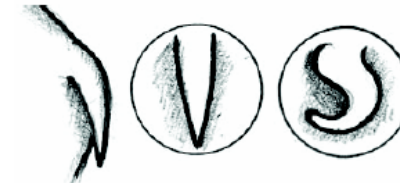

**TAIL** – The tail may be either straight or “screwed” (but never curved or curly), and in any case must be short, hung low, with decided downward carriage, thick root and fine tip. If straight, the tail should be cylindrical and of uniform taper. If “screwed”, the bends or kinks should be well defined, and they may be abrupt and even knotty, but no portion of the member should be elevated above the base of root.

Two types of tail are desired in the Standard, each is short, hung low, heading downward with thick root and fine tip.

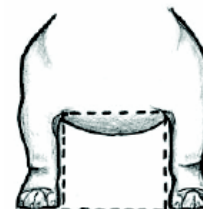

**FOREQUARTERS**

**SHOULDERS** – The shoulders should be muscular, very heavy, widespread and slanting outward, giving stability and great power. **FORELEGS** – The forelegs should be short, very stout, straight and muscular, set wide apart, with well developed calves, presenting a bowed outline, but the bones of the legs should not be curved or bandy, nor the feet brought too close together.



Correct turn of shoulder with proper front legs will show straight perpendicular inner forelegs. A correct front will form a near square from the top of the legs, across and down.
