Corrections:

Link made the motion to accept the April Meeting Minutes w/ the corrections noted above, Cristian seconded, Motion passed.

AKC DELEGATE: Link no longer able to serve as our AKC Delegate as he has taken over Bob Newcomb's position as BCA Delegate. Link will remain the Club's delegate until such time a replacement is decided.

EDUCATION: Kathy Gray. Table until able to do regular meeting

BCA UPDATE: Cristian spoke to the various topics of the Division meeting.

1. The Las Vegas Specialty is scheduled for October 9-11 in conjunction with the Black Mtn KC. The Division will also hold a generic Specialty on Saturday following the All-Breed show.
2. The Nationals are still a go in Myrtle Beach, S.C.
3. The Division will hold a generic Specialty in January in conjunction with the Sand to Sea Non-Sporting KC in Indio, the Judge will be Karen McFarlane.
4. The Division will hold it's designated Specialty with the Phoenix BC on either Friday or Saturday, still TBD.

BULLPUP: Cristian noted all is good.

BREEDER'S AND FUTURITY MATCH: The matches have been moved up to the September 9th church meeting to allow for more daylight. Judges are Carmel Hupe for Breeder's match and Cyndee Paulus for Futurity match.

CHALLENGE TROPHIES: Lesley. To be presented Sept 20, Sunday before show starts. Lesley is on target.

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS: Dennis sent Mike Lerchenmuller a sample plaque for a cost estimate to supply 24 plaques.

FUN MATCH: Brenda noted no update to the matches for 2021.

MEMBERSHIP: Cristian noted we have 96 current members and we have lost 36 this year. Cristian to reach out to those not renewing to see if they will.

SOCIAL MEDIA: Sherry. We will send her any updates on Club activities to post to our website.

2019 SPECIALTY: Link reported the audit is now completed and will provide details in the following Board meeting.

2020 SPECIALTY: Dennis and Lalaine

- Link was able to secure the Sale Pavilion of the Los Alamitos Race Course at no cost to the club!
- The theme will be Bullies Run for the Roses. We decided to use the White Bulldog artwork Scot Provided as the theme.
- Lalaine has secured the Residence Inn next door to our show site as host hotel. Cost is \$120 for a studio which is 1 bed with a sleeper sofa plus a \$50 pet non-refundable fee {lowered from \$100}. We will encourage exhibitors to stay at the host hotel as it is literally next door to show site. I am asking the hotel to open up fence between grass area and hotel for walk through access (pending). We will also list other pet friendly hotels in the area.
- Temporary use permit was faxed to Los Alamitos, awaiting receipt then send to City of Cypress.
- Tables and chairs: will need 3 for hospitality, 2 for raffle, 3 for ring steward/judges' table and trophies, 1 for show secretary, 3 for lunch. 30 chairs (people bring their own chairs as well). I have asked Bill Gray to please look into tables and chairs rental from Bradshaw.

- Lalaine spoke with Kathy Gray about hospitality. She has a menu planned that will be within budget and she will need 1 week notice about expected number of people to feed.
- Please do not forget to bring your raffle items. See Kathy Hairston.
- All the Judges have been secured via a viable or written acceptance. All contracts sent. Teresa McDermott w/ Cindy Carlson Sweeps Sat AM, Zack Lane w/ Judy Dorough Juniors – Sat PM, and Roxanne Williamson Sunday AM.
- 2020 Specialty - Review PL draft and finalize Logo or ask for additional Logo submittals.
- Scott to remove the NOHS ribbon from the Trophy Donation page of the proposed Premium List.

BRAGS: No Brags were made as this was a video conference call.

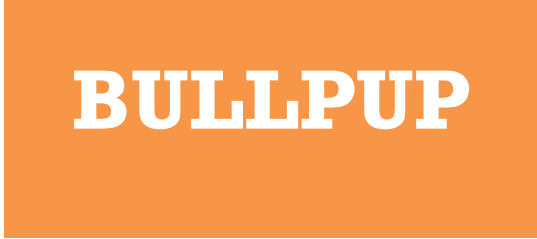
ADJOURN: Kay made the motion to adjourn the General Meeting at 7:58pm, Willie seconded, Motion passed.

Championship Award Rules

1. The recipient of the Champion Plaque must receive at least ten (10) points, including one (1) major in the following locations: San Luis Obispo County, Fresno County, Kern County, Tulare County, Kings County, all Southern California Counties, all shows put on by a Bulldog Specialty Club held in Division III, and the National Bulldog Specialty no matter where held.
2. All legal owners and co-owners of the dog **MUST** be members of Pacific Coast Bulldog Club, Inc. in good standing at the time the required ten (10) points, including one (1) major are earned.
3. Those who apply for a plaque and do not meet the requirements will receive a Championship Certificate. All members who finish a Champion in the United States, regardless of locality, are entitled to a Championship Certificate and may apply for only the certificate by checking the appropriate box.
4. The Championship Award Application can be obtained from the Championship Award Chairperson or the Bullpup Editor.
5. The completed application must be submitted with a copy of the AKC Championship Certificate, the AKC Registration Certificate, and an 8x10 colored show photo or a good quality colored photocopy of the new champion no later than December 31st of the year prior to the Specialty Show to the Championship Award Chairperson. The photo will be retained as part of the permanent records of the Pacific Coast Bulldog Club, Inc.
6. The first plaque per recipient is free. Additional plaques may be purchased at the time of application for \$50 (fifty dollars).

Check the box at the bottom of the application form and enclose a check made out to P.C.B.C. with application and mail to the Championship Award Chairperson at the address below.

Futurity Match, Rules:

1. Only puppies bred by members in good standing with the Pacific Coast Bulldog Club, Inc. are eligible;
2. The Futurity Match will be held at the August regular meeting unless mentioned otherwise;
3. The Bitch is nominated prior to the breeding or no later than two (2) weeks after the actual meeting;
4. The nomination fee is ten dollars (\$10.00). No additional fees are required after the litter is born;
5. To keep litter eligible, the member must advise the Futurity Chairperson of the date, the number and sex of the puppies before the puppies are sixty (60) days old or ten (10) days prior to the judging of the Match, whichever comes first;
6. Puppies three (3) months and under fifteen (15) months are eligible;
7. All fees to be paid to the futurity Chairperson;
8. Futurity Chairperson may also show at the match;
9. Puppies with points or championship may show at this match;
10. Puppies can only be shown once in a Futurity; &
11. The breeder must be a member in good standing on the date of the Match for the puppies to be shown.

Division of the Futurity Money:

12. Ten percent (10%) to be deducted for expenses;
13. Futurity Chairperson will purchase ribbons for First through Fourth Place;
14. The remaining money is to be divided as follows: First place receives fourth percent (40%), Second Place receives thirty percent (30%), Third Place receives twenty percent (20%), Fourth Place receives ten percent (10%); &
15. The club will provide a trophy to go to the First Place Winner to be held for one (1) year. Permanent possession will be after three (3) wins of First Place. Not necessarily in succession.

JUDGE WILL BE SELECTED ACCORDING TO RULES FOR SELECTION OF JUDGES. SLATE OF JUDGE NOMINATIONS SHALL BE VOTED ON TWO GENERAL MEETINGS PRIOR TO THE FUTURITY.

MANNER IN WHICH ENTRIES ARE JUDGED:

16. If the number of entries is less than fifteen (15), then they are judged as one class, regardless of sex;
17. If there are fifteen (15) or more entries, the class will be divided into Juniors and Seniors. Under and over six (6) months respectfully, regardless of sex; &
18. From each class, the judge selects four (4) best entrants, then from the eight (8) finalists, the judge awards First, Second, Third, and Fourth.
